



Test Technician

Summary: Perform test processes to ensure and verify that equipment/instrumentation produced by DYNEX manufacturing conforms and meets published specifications.

Responsibilities: Electro-Mechanical assembly using standard tool box items (screwdrivers, pliers, wrenches, vices, assembly tools, calipers, depth gauge, and assembly fixtures, etc.). Test and verify proper performance of Dynex manufactured products. Ensure that the procedures and qualification tools used during testing are correct. Verify that all tests have been performed and are acceptable prior to release to consolidation. Fill out all testing documentation (QC folders, scrap forms, test summary sheets, etc.) Inform the appropriate departments of non-conforming issues found during testing. Offer suggestions for improvement of testing processes. Follow all implemented Lean Manufacturing Techniques and Barcoding process. Perform other work related duties as assigned.
